

ITALIAN LANGUAGE COURSES

A1 LEVEL

Course objectives

The course offers an introduction to the Italian language. The lessons deal with the study of the standard Italian language. At the end of the course, students will be able to read and understand basic level texts and hold a conversation about daily life topics. The acquired knowledge will allow the students to reach the A1 level of the European Framework of Reference for Languages.

A2 LEVEL

Course objectives

The Italian course level A2 is intended for students having some basic knowledge of Italian. Its main objective is to consolidate the knowledge students have of the basic structures of the language, and to develop abilities in the comprehension and production of oral and written language in everyday contexts of use.

Course structure and teaching resources(A1/A2 levels)

The course is made up of 30 lessons in e-learning mode, each of them divided into 5 sections.

The first section presents the dialogue of the lesson, followed by a listening, and some exercises of comprehension, spelling and pronunciation.

In the second, third and fourth sections, specific aspects of the language contained in the initial dialogue are examined in detail. The analysis focuses on lexicon, grammar and communicative functions related to the situation brought out in the lesson.

The fifth and last section summarizes the main topics of the lesson. An oral activity with the use of structures learned in the previous sections is proposed with the aim of adapting them for similar situations.



Each lesson is followed by a series of exercises that come after the first 4 learning sections, the Pdf of the slides used during the videos and 2 mp3 and mp4 files containing the audio and video of the reference dialogue, respectively.

A chat gives the opportunity to discuss the specific topics of the lessons.

Lessons 10, 20 and 30 are devoted to a summary of the lexicon, grammar and communicative functions presented in the 9 lessons immediately preceding each of them.
