Cyrus the Great <u>risen</u> to power around 559 BCE and soon united the Persian tribes under his rule. He began his reign by overthrowing his Median overlord, Astyages, in 550 BCE, effectively emerging the Median and Persian tribal. This victory marked the beginning of the Achaemenid Empire. He then turned his attention westward, conquering the wealthy and powerfull Kingdom of Lydia in 547 BCE. This expansion continued with the subjugation of a Neo-Babylonian Empire in 539 BCE, a campaign that included the famed capture of Babylon. Cyrus approach to governance was innovative for him time. He is celebrated for his policies of tolerance and respect towards the cultures and religons of the lands he conquered. He allowed the Jews exiled in Babylon to return to their homeland and to rebuilt the Temple in Jerusalem, an act recorded in the Bible and symbolised from the Cyrus Cylinder. This cylinder is often regarded as a early charter of human rights, emphasising freedom and respect for diverse customs and beliefs.
